



1 Vox Phonetography Definitions

1. "Vox Phonetography" refers to the group of Software and Services provided under the name "Vox Phonetography", including, but not limited to: (1) Vox Phonetography Software, (e.g. the Praat plugin "plugin_Vox_Phonetography_vXX.XX" and all files and folders it contains including the installer "INSTALL.praat"); (2) Vox Phonetography User Manual (and other documentation when applicable); (3) Vox Phonetography Services: all updates to the Vox Phonetography Software and User Manual, if any, which are needed to maintain the software functionality/ stability and performance.
2. "Vox Supplements" refers to the separate Software and Services that enhance or expand Vox Phonetography with more functionality, aimed at clinical practice, scientific work and/or statistical analysis. Vox Supplements are not included in Vox Phonetography and serve as separate entities, which must therefore be purchased separately, also from the Phonanium website (www.phonanium.com).
3. "Author" refers to Mr. Marthè Nijkamp. Any referral to "Vox Phonetography" is a direct referral to its author Mr. Nijkamp. The author can be contacted by email on nijkamp.marthe@gmail.com.

2 Terms, Conditions and License

1. Vox Phonetography Software and Services are sold by Phonanium. "Phonanium" refers to Mr. Youri Maryn, offering the Software and Services under the tradename Phonanium, having its offices at Papestraat 62, 9160 Lokeren, Belgium. Therefore, By using Vox Phonetography, the user agrees with the Phonanium General Terms and Conditions (<https://www.phonanium.com/general-terms-conditions/>), which applies to all Software and Services that are purchased and downloaded from the Phonanium website (www.phonanium.com).
2. These General Terms and Conditions are considered as formally and explicitly accepted by the Customer as soon as the Customer has downloaded the Software. They prevail upon the general or special terms and conditions of Customer, unless Phonanium has accepted the Customer's conditions explicitly and in writing.
3. These General Terms and Conditions are without prejudice to the application of the GNU General Public License on the software PRAAT (http://www.fon.hum.uva.nl/praat/GNU_General_Public_License.txt), which will prevail when applicable.
4. The Customer, when having purchased and downloaded Vox Phonetography, is licensed to use the Vox Phonetography Software and Services and install the Vox Phonetography plugin on maximally *three* computers excluding one backup. The license includes updates (as noted in 1.1 point (3)) but excludes future major versions of Vox Phonetography.

3 Help and assistance

Personal help, assistance or courses are charged by Phonanium and will be provided by the author himself. These exclude assistance per email, which is always free and available to all customers of Vox Phonetography Software and Services. Personal help, assistance and courses include Personal help or assistance: (1) per videochat or by controlling the customers computer (Skype, TeamViewer); (2) in person (at location), which is only available within the Netherlands and Belgium; and (3) a course in person (at location), only available within the Netherlands and Belgium, including installation, calibration and education in phonetography theory and practice. A customer can contact the author by email with a request for personal help, assistance or courses.
